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The **Investigator Initiated Clinical Trials (IICT) 2022 call** of the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) requests that applicants address their approach to **patient and public involvement (PPI)** both in their letter of intent (LOI) as well as in the application itself.

This PPI in a Nutshell online course is targeted towards **clinical research professionals who are considering applying for an IICT 2022 grant**. It discusses why PPI is particularly useful for the planning and development of clinical trials and provides hands-on advice and examples for an effective and meaningful PPI approach.
